# Drug and alcohol testing consortium

## Random Selection

Following DOT guidelines, our software selects names randomly from our DOT Driver Random Pool population:

- **Pull Rate**—50% drug, 10% alcohol—annual percentage of the total pool population to be tested.
- **Pull Frequency**—monthly—times per year when names are selected.

## Testing Methods

- **Drug Testing.** A Chain Of Custody (COC) refers to chronological documentation (paper trail), showing seizure, custody, control, transfer, analysis, disposition of a urine specimen.
- **Breath Alcohol Test.** A Federally approved, regulated device used to estimate blood alcohol content.

## DOT Drug Screen Components

Cannabinoids, Cocaine, Phencyclidine, Heroin, Amphetamines, Opiates, MDMA/Ecstasy,

## Testing Locations

- **DMH Corporate Health Services:** Priority treatment given to a driver who presents for a random drug and/or alcohol test. Drug results will be sent to

the designated employer contact within 48 hours. Alcohol results are available immediately.

- **Locations Outside of Decatur:** DMH Corporate Health will supply DOT Driver Testing Kits for each fleet vehicle. When a driver must attend another USA clinic, this kit will be required. The clinic will have a collection processing fee for each drug test. If applicable, the clinic will charge for a breath alcohol test. For budgetary purposes, assume collection fee at other clinics, \$15; breath alcohol test, \$30.

## Pricing

No annual enrollment fee. As an employer, you are charged only when an employed driver is randomly selected and completes a drug and/or alcohol screen.
